The Administration of the University of Liberia has learned with profound regrets the sudden death of Prof. Daniel Musah from the Economics Department, College of Business and Public Administration. This sad event occurred on April 9, 2018 at the John F. Kennedy Memorial Hospital after a brief illness.

According to family sources, the mortal remains of Assistant Professor Daniel Musah has been deposited at the A.B Anderson Funeral home pending funeral arrangements. The Family through the Human Resource Department, has also informed the UL Administration that funeral service over the remains of the late Assistant Professor will be held on Saturday, April 28, 2018 at the E. Harding Smythe Memorial United Methodist Church, located on Smythe Road, Sinkor Old Road. Thereafter, the mortal remains will be taken to Division #10, Firestone Plantation's Company, Margibi County, where he Will be interred.

Assistant Prof. Musah was a 1987 graduate of the University of Liberia with a B. Sc (Cum Laude ) degree in Economics, and a post graduate degree in population studies from the Republic of Ghana between 1989 and 1990.

The late professor was employed by the University of Liberia on December 20, 1992 as instructor II. Before his demise, he taught both in the demography, he also taught several junior level courses and several overloads in the department of Economics.

The Visitor, the Administration of the university, the Board of Trustees, faculty and staff members and the entire student populace extend deepest condolences to the bereaved family for the irreparable loss sustained.
