2021 FIRST ENTRANCE RESULTS

June 7, 2021

INTRODUCTION

The University of Liberia customarily administers entrance and placement exams as part of the vetting process of admission. The test is intended to help determine selection of those who are at least capable of doing college course work without further high school preparation.

This year 2021 FIRST ENTRANCE AND PLACEMENT EXAMINATION RESULTS for the Undergraduate Colleges, Straz Sinje, and the College of General Studies fall into four categories:

- ① **REGULAR PASS**
- ② **PROVISIONAL PASS**
- ③ **UNSUCCESSFUL**
- ④ **ABSENT** and **DISQUALIFIED**.

THE SCALE USED :

- 1 **REGULAR PASS** candidates are those who scored at least 50% in Mathematics and at least 50% in English. REGULAR PASS candidates may register for up to 18 credit hours during their first semester in a college of the University of Liberia.

PROVISIONAL PASS

- ② **PROVISIONAL PASS** candidates are those who scored less than 50% in Mathematics or less than 50% in English but obtained an average score of at least 50% when their mathematics and English scores are combined. PROVISIONAL PASS candidates may register for up to 12 or 13 credit-hours during their first semester in a college of the University of Liberia. The credit hours should include Freshman Mathematics and Freshman English.

UNSUCCESSFUL PASS & ABSENT

- ③ **UNSUCCESSFUL** candidates are those who have an average score of less than 50% when their mathematics and English scores are combined. UNSUCCESSFUL candidates must register again for another UL entrance examination and obtain a pass mark/grade in that exam before they can gain entry to the University of Liberia.
- ④ **ABSENT** candidates are those who registered for the University of Liberia entrance but did not turn out for the Entrance Examination. Candidates that were absent must register again for another UL entrance examination and obtain a pass mark/grade in that exam before they can gain entry to the University of Liberia.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

A total of eleven thousand two hundred ninety-nine (**11,299**) candidates registered for the entrance for Under Graduate, Sinje Vocational College and the College of General Studies. Of this number, only eleven thousand, one hundred sixty-three (**11,163 or 98.8%**) candidates wrote the Exam, one candidate (**1 or 0.01%**) was disqualified while one hundred thirty-five (**135 or 1.19%**) candidates were absent. Of the total eleven thousand, one hundred sixty-three (**11,163**) candidates who wrote the Entrance Exams, four thousand, six hundred seventy-one (**4,671 or 41.84%**) candidates passed regularly, eight hundred sixty-eight (**868 or 7.78%**) students passed provisionally while five thousand, six hundred twenty-four (**5,624 or 50.38%**) candidates were unsuccessful.

This also means that only five thousand, five hundred thirty-nine (**5,539 or 49.62%**) candidates made either a Regular Pass or a Provisional Pass.

The Medical School

SCALE USED FOR THE MEDICAL SCHOOL

SUCCESSFUL PASS: Candidates who scored is at least 50% in Science and atleast 50% in English.

UNSUCCESSFUL PASS: Candidates who failed to score at least 50% in Science and atleast 50% in English.

The Medical School cont

- The total of two hundred sixty-four(**264**) candidates registered for the Medical School Aptitude Test. Of this number, five(**5**) candidates were absent.
- Of the total two hundred fifty-nine (**259**) candidates that wrote the Medical School Aptitude Test, fifty-seven (**57 or 22.01%**) candidates were successful while two hundred-two (**202 or 77.99%**) candidates were UNSUCCESSFUL. Of the fifty-seven successful candidates, ten (**10 or 17.54%**) candidates are females while forty-seven (**47 or 82.46%**) are males.

The School of Pharmacy

SCALE USED

SUCCESSFUL PASS: Candidates whose average score is at least 38%.

UNSUCCESSFUL PASS: Candidates whose average score is less than 38%.

- The total of fifty (**50**) candidates registered for the Medical School Aptitude Test. All fifty candidates were present.
- Of the total of fifty (**50**) candidates that wrote the School of Pharmacy Aptitude Test, thirty-nine (**39 or 78%**) candidates were successful while eleven (**11 or 22%**) were UNSUCCESSFUL. Of the thirty-nine (**39 or 78%**) successful candidates, five (**5 or 12.82%**) candidates are females while forty-seven (**34 or 82.18%**) are males.

SCALE USED

SUCCESSFUL PASS: Candidates whose average scored is at least 35%.

UNSUCCESSFUL PASS: Candidates whose average scored is less than 35%.

- The total of five hundred fifty-four(**504**) candidates registered for the Graduate School Aptitude Test.
